

### 1 WHAT IS THE SCHEDULED ROUTE?

Our scheduled bus route circles Picton, then heads to Belleville via Bloomfield,

returns and circles Picton again, five times a day, five days a week (Monday-Friday).

Folks can ride to Belleville and back for school, work, appointments, connections to VIA Rail and more. Ask the driver for a free transfer onto Belleville Transit.

Since the route circles Picton both before and after Belleville, it's also useful for getting around Picton.

## Student / Senior Specialized

\$2.50 within Picton  
\$4.25 to Bloomfield  
\$7 to Belleville

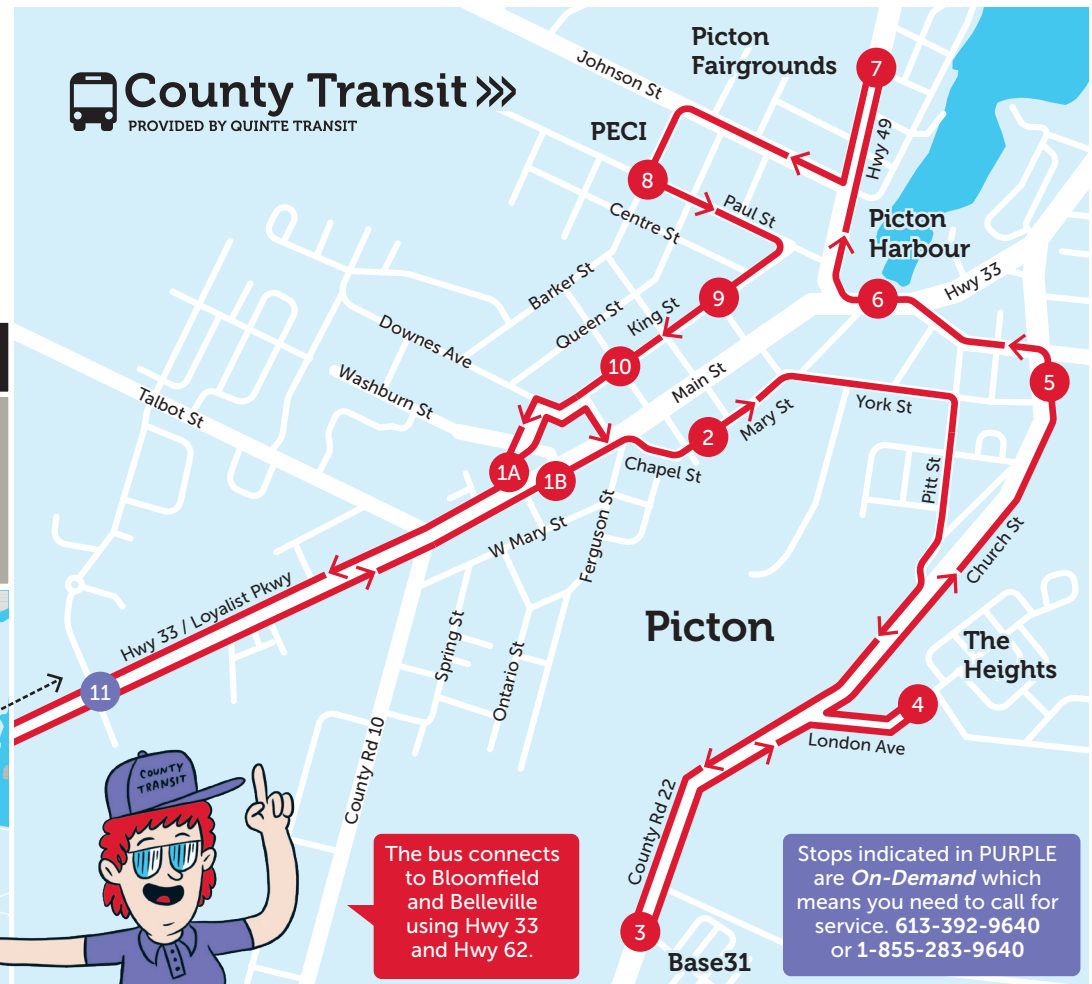
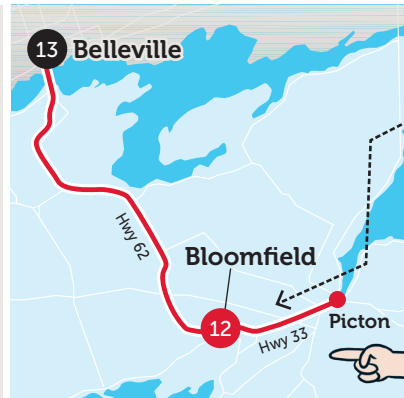
## Children (6-11)

## About the schedule

- The times at each stop are listed below each stop name.
- The bus moves in the same direction as the schedule. Left to right shows where the bus stops next.
- For all timed stops in the schedule, buses always run either on time or slightly late.
- The bus will wait at timed stops until the scheduled time. Be there 5 minutes before.
- If your stop is untimed, be there at the time for the prior stop.
